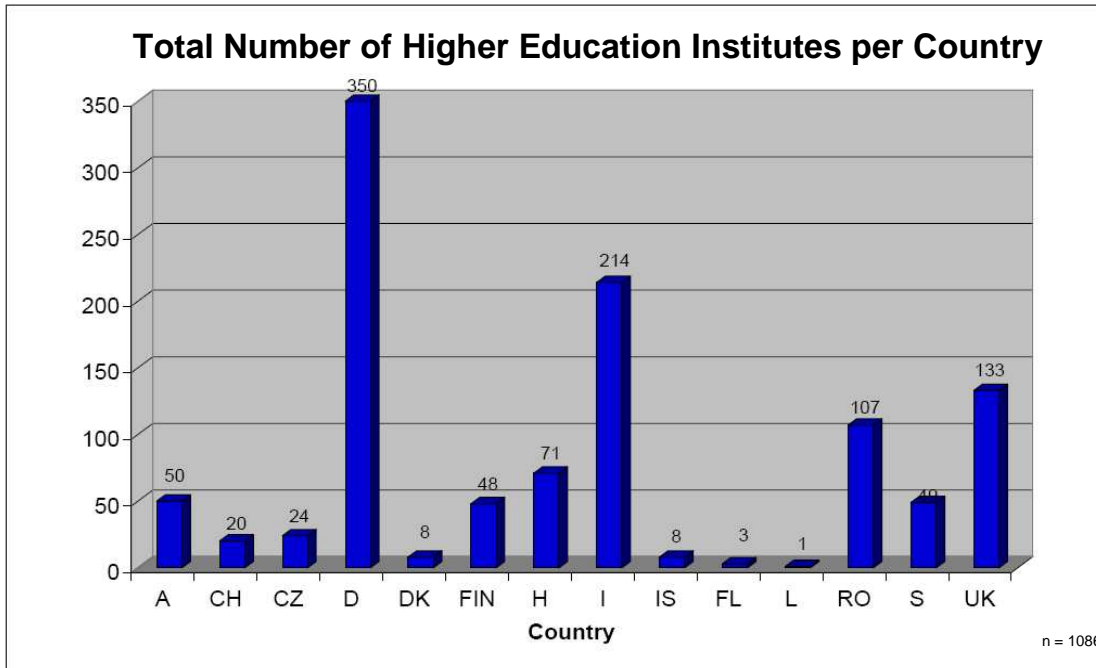

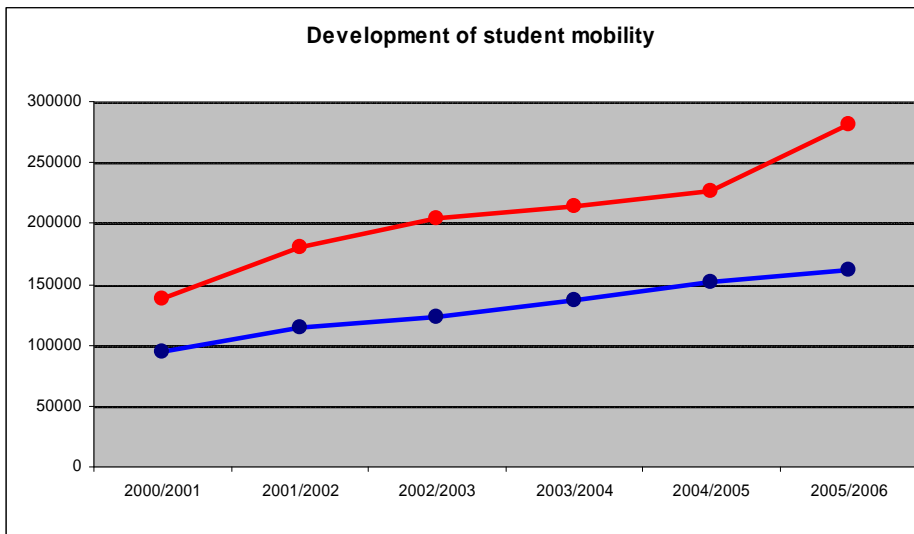

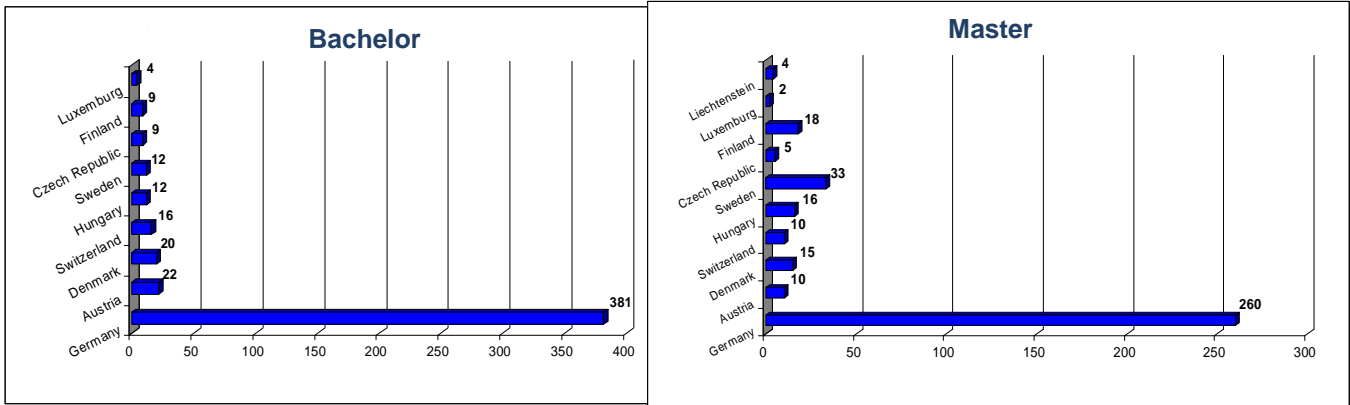

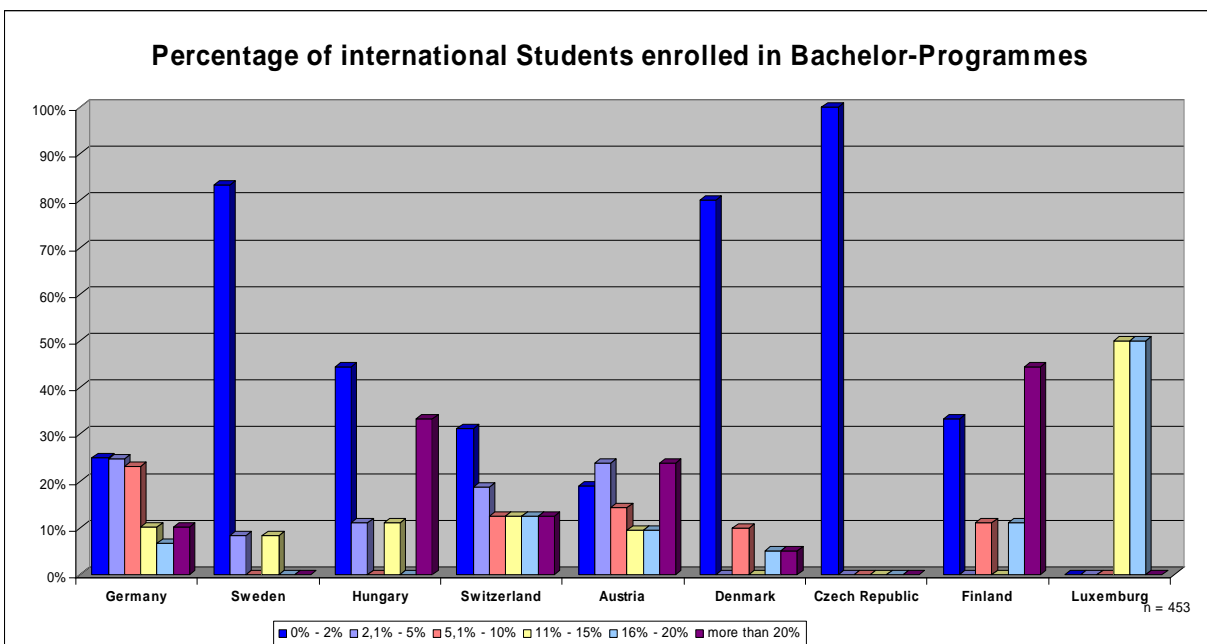

Number of Participating Programmes per Country



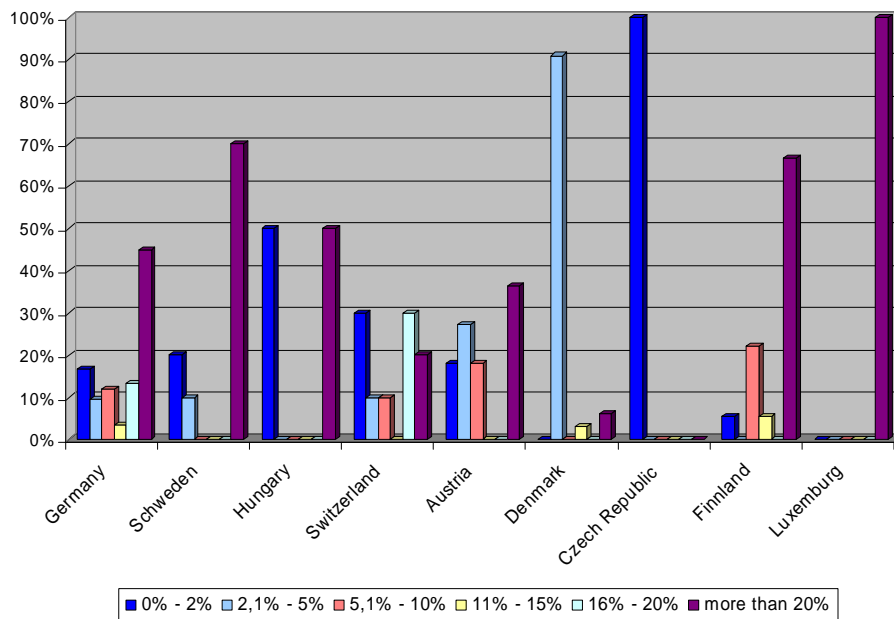

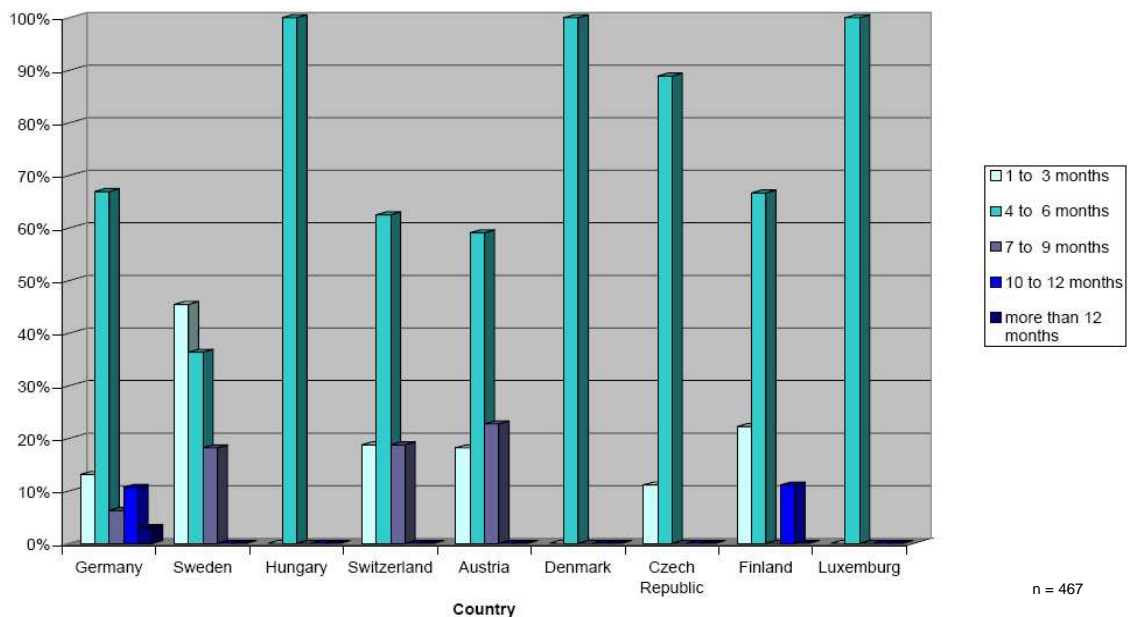

Percentage of international Students enrolled into Master-Programmes



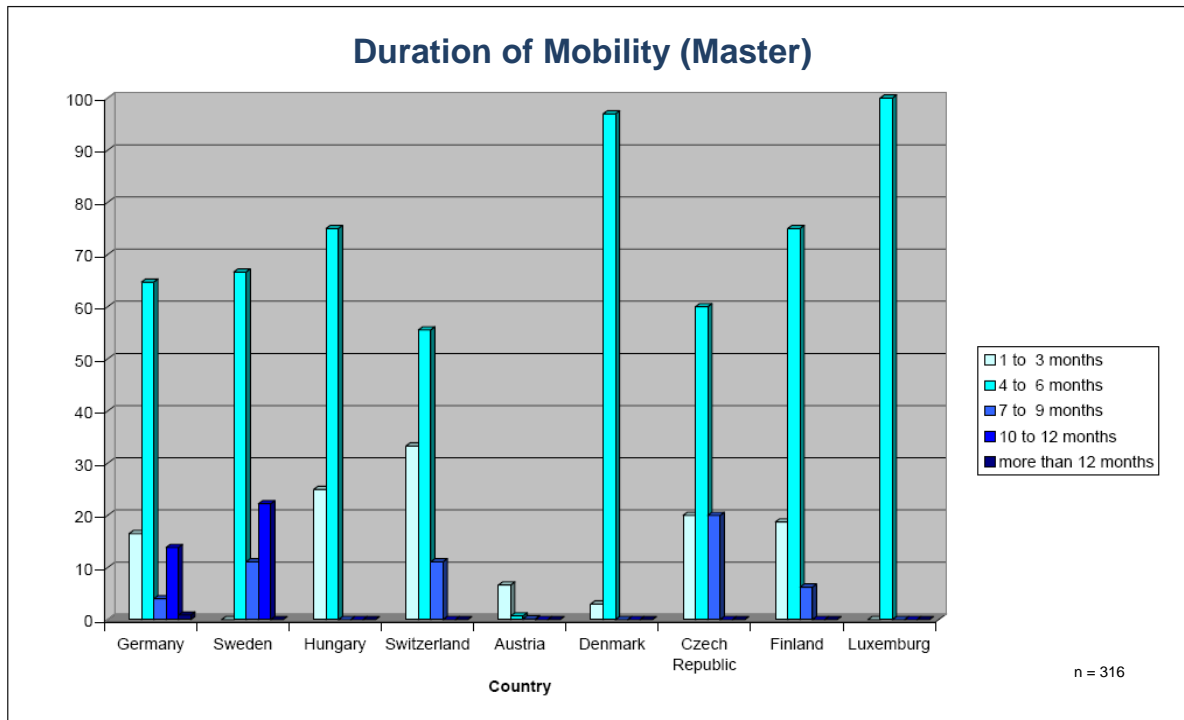

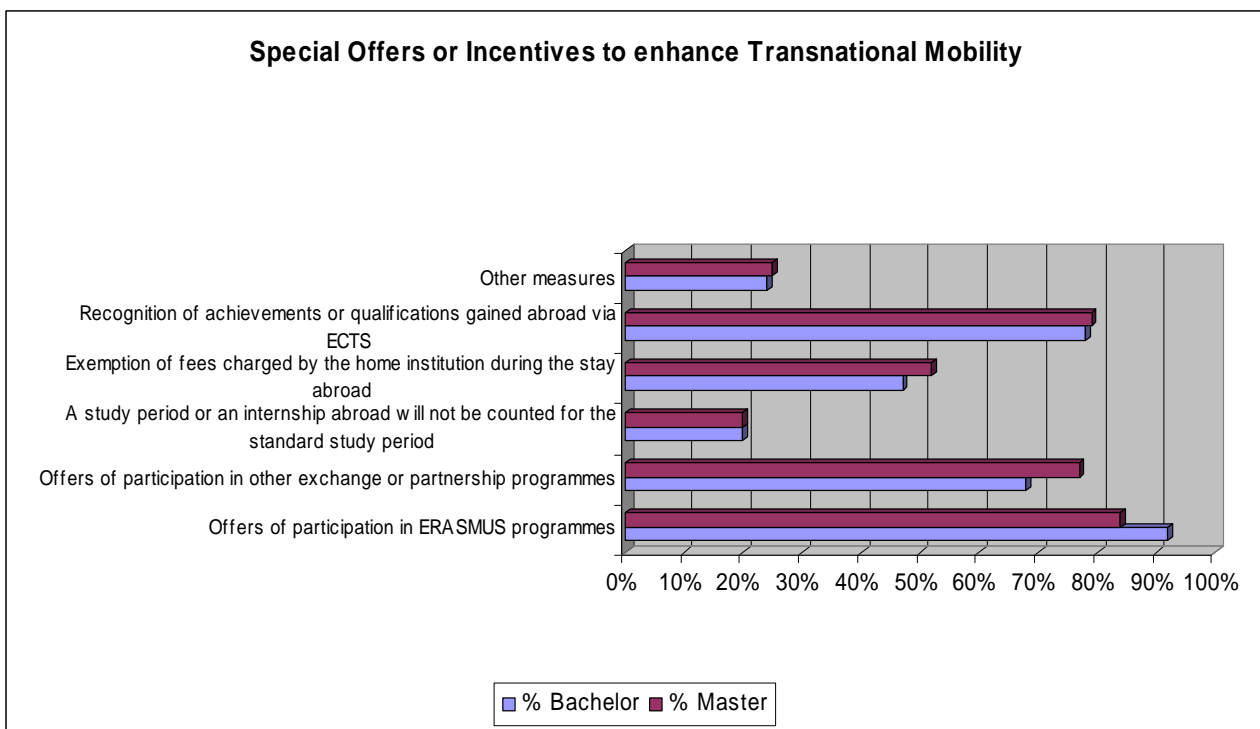

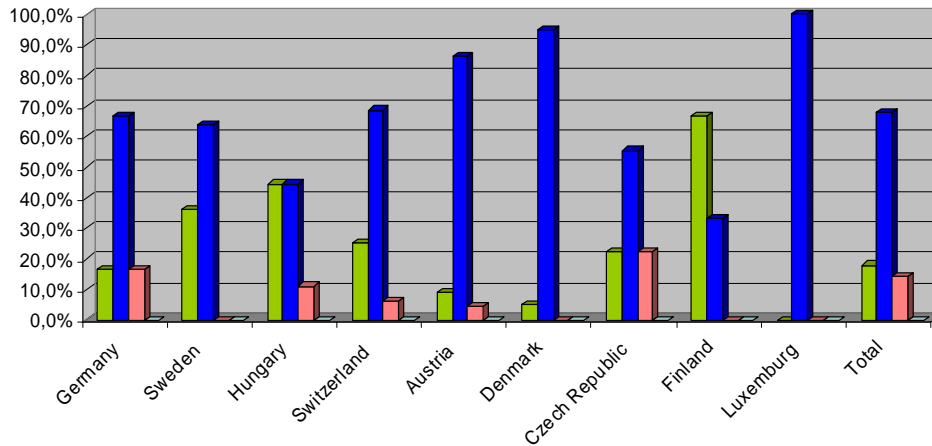

To what extent are achievements acquired abroad recognised in your study programme? (Bachelor)

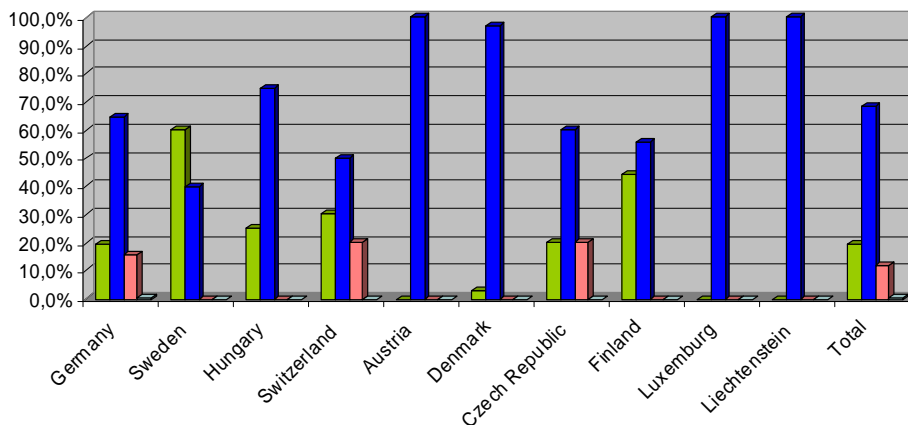

To what extent will achievements acquired abroad recognised in your study programme? (Master)



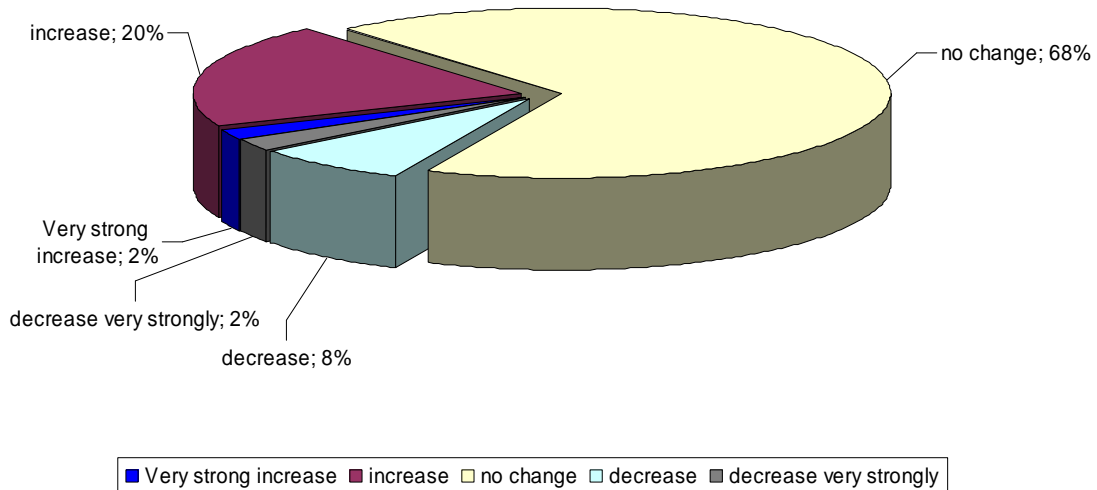

If the Bachelor-Programme is the successor of a traditional study programme, how did student mobility develop after the re-organisation?

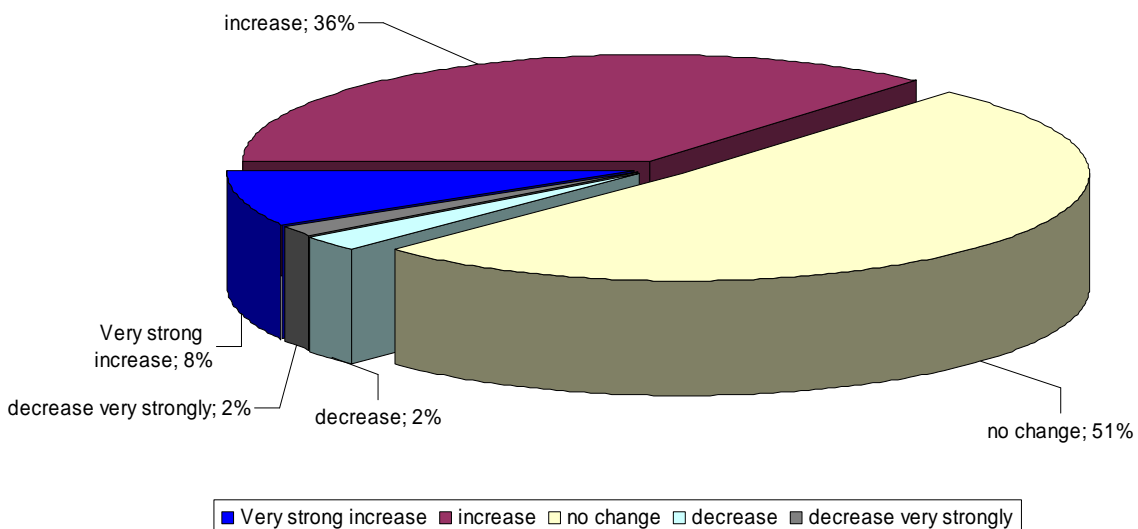

If the Master-Programme is the successor of a traditional study programme, how did student mobility develop after the re-organisation?

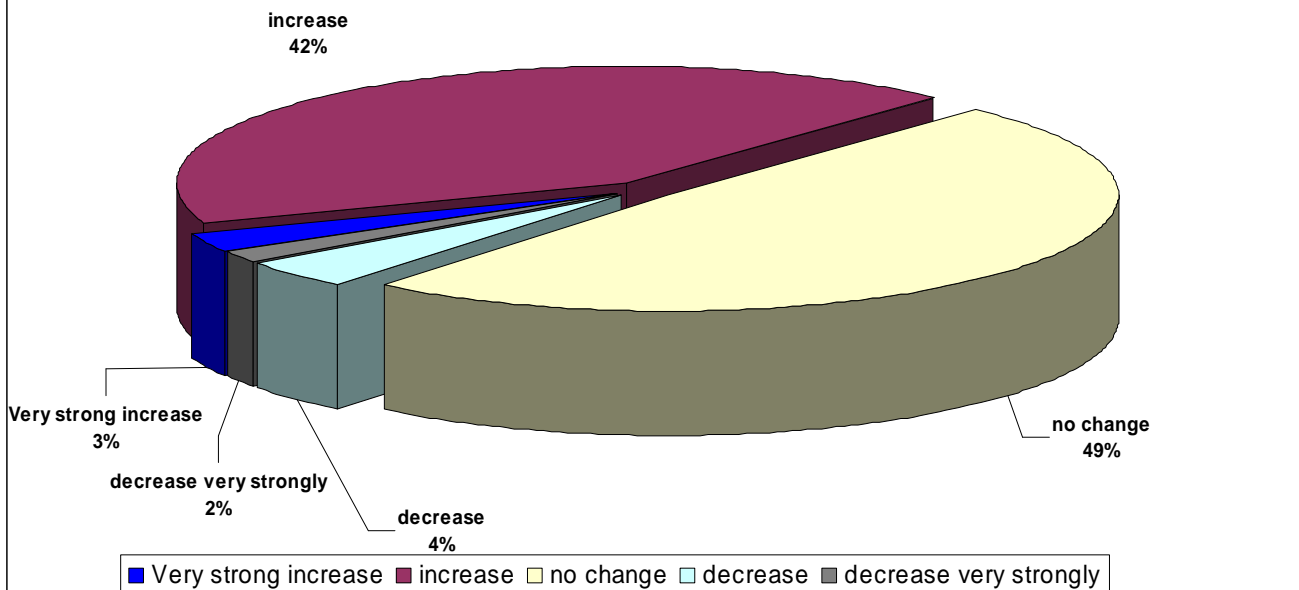

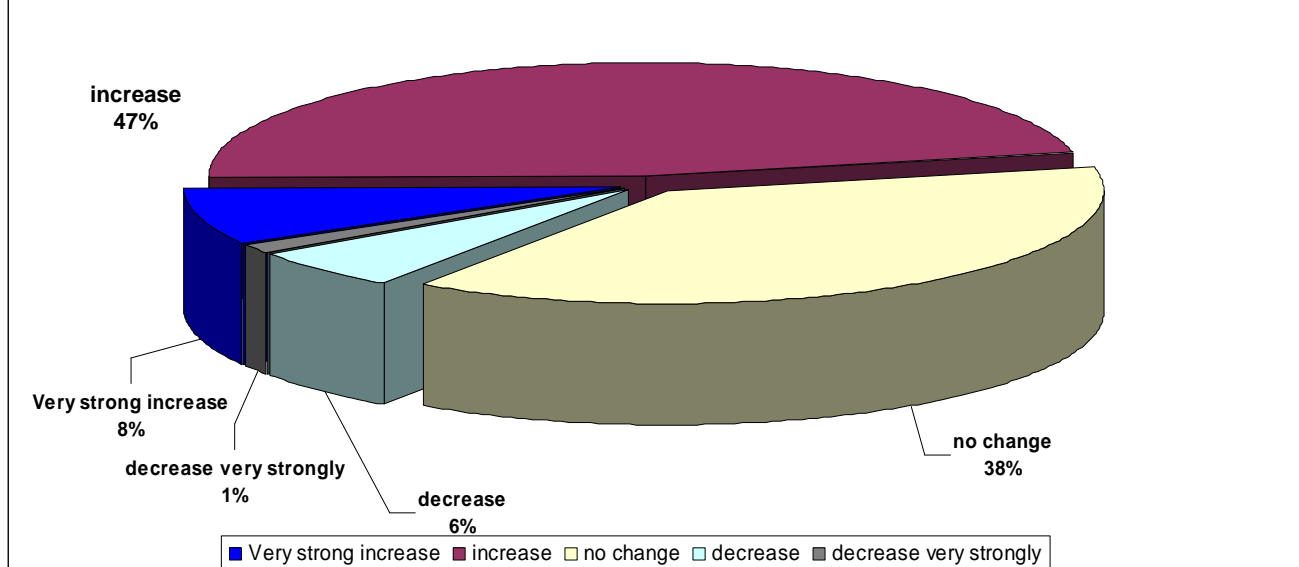

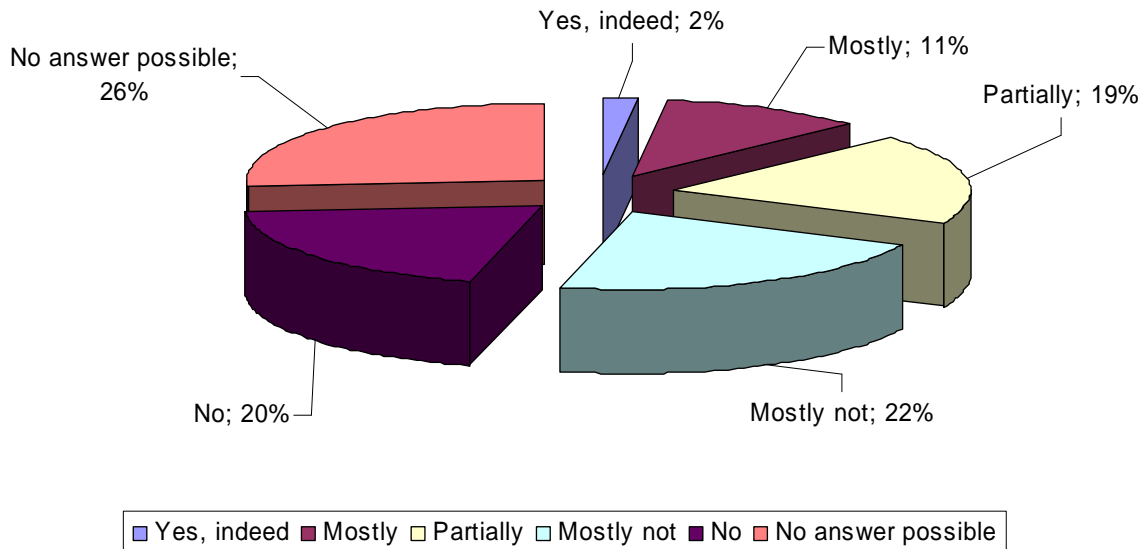
