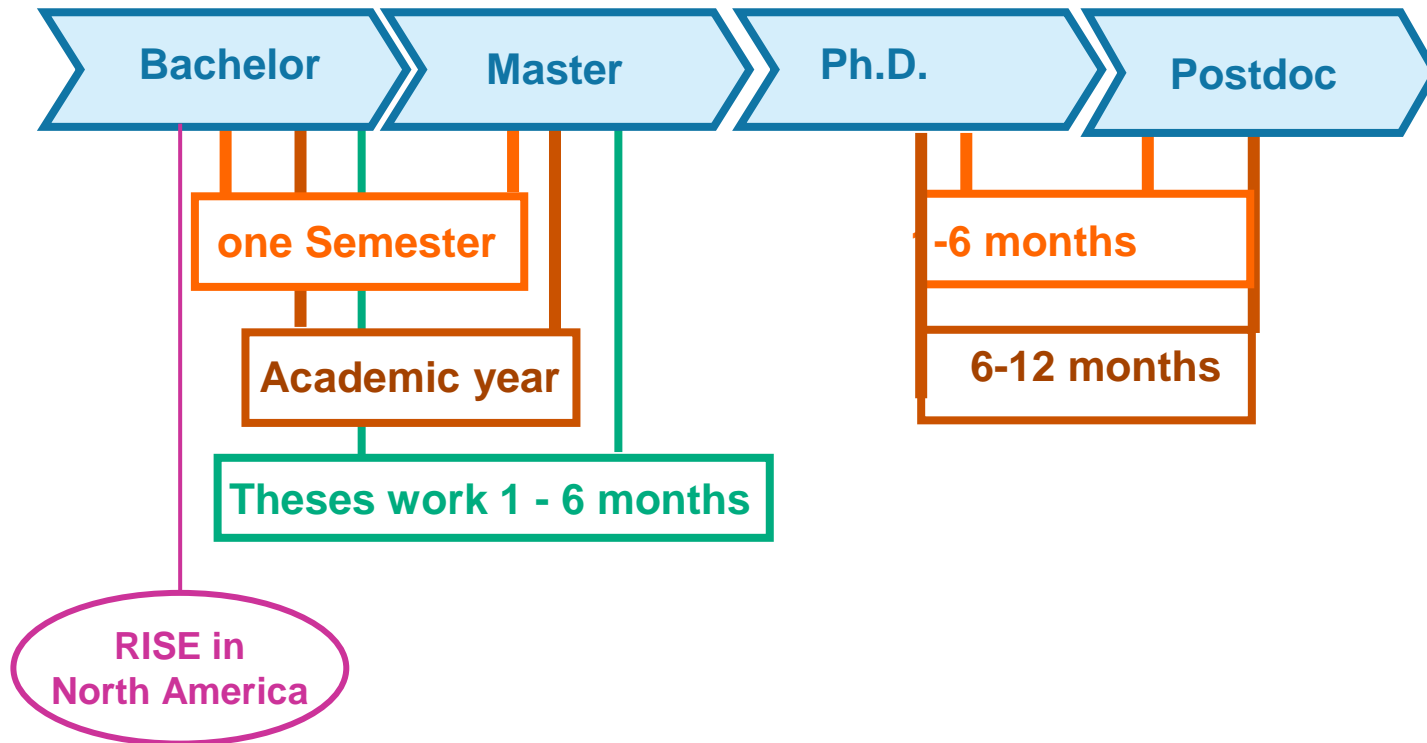

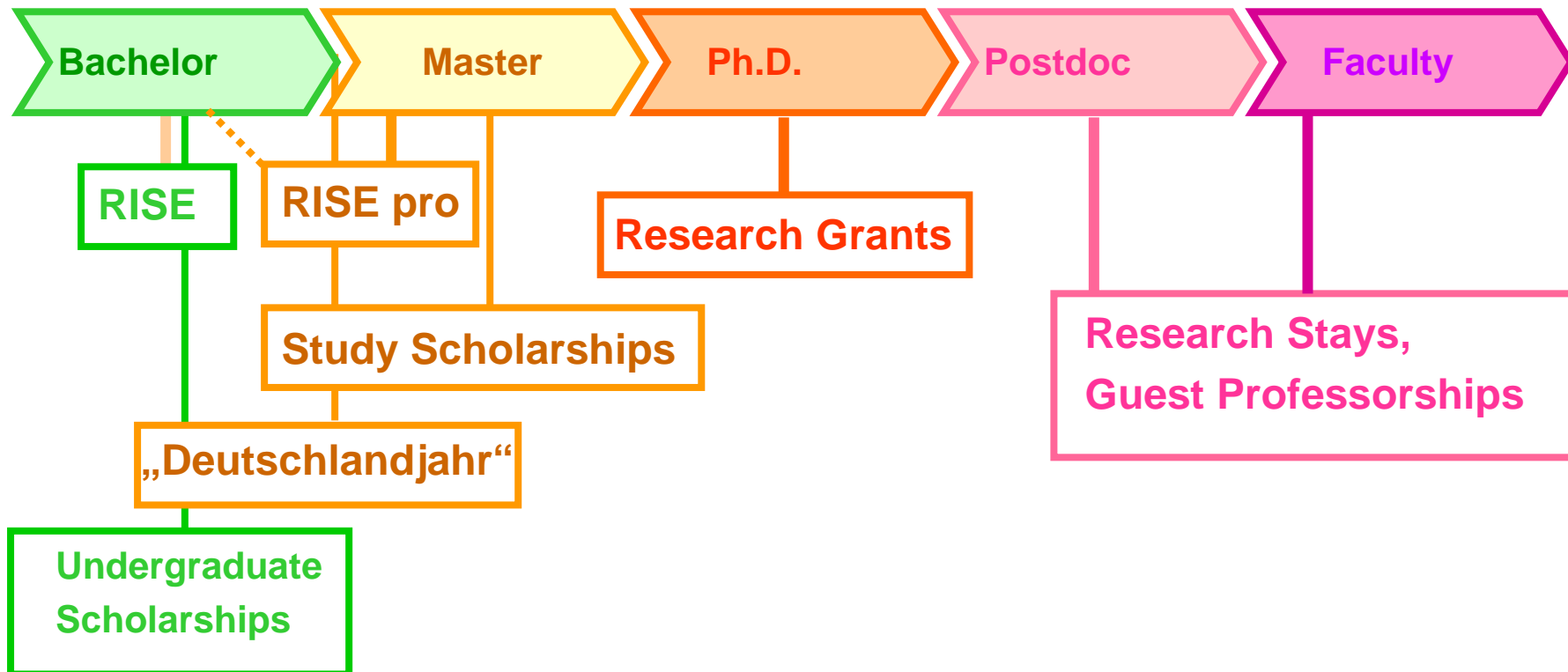
DAAD Funding for Germans (individual scholarships)

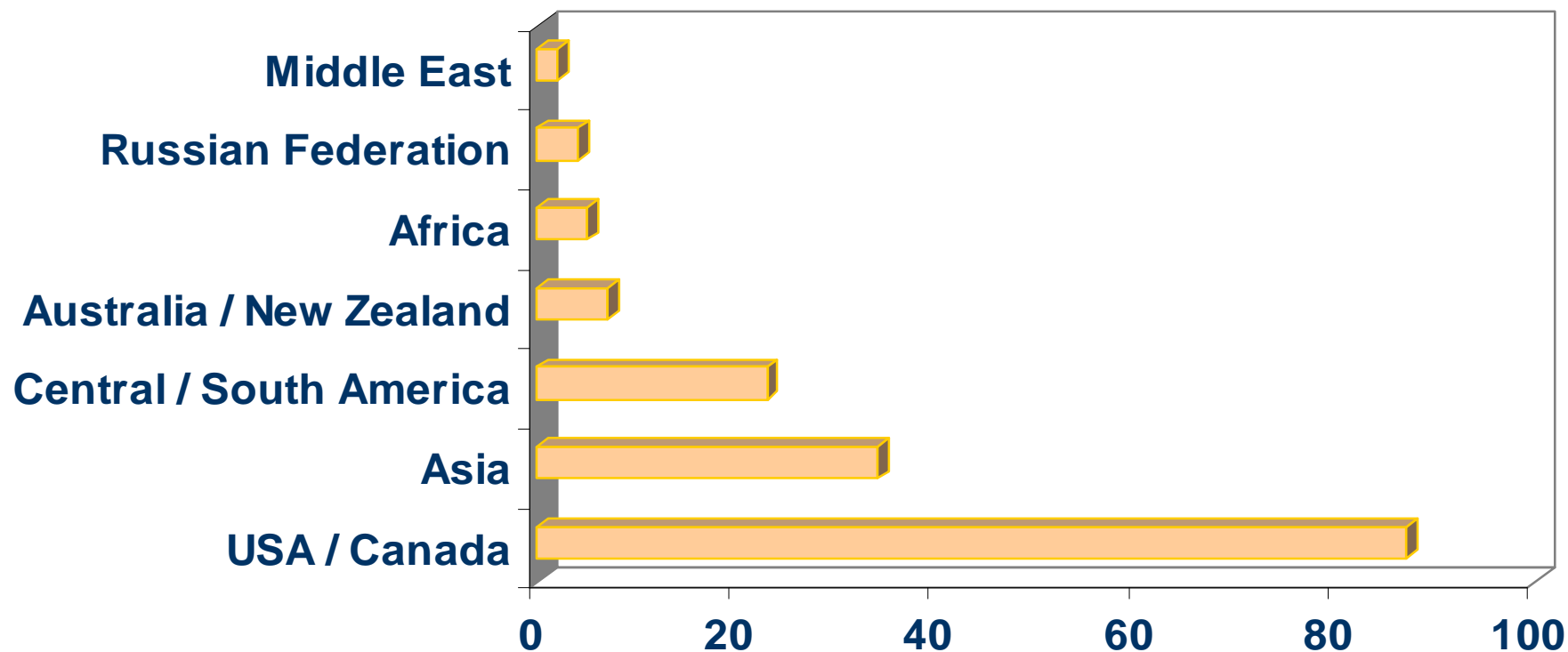
„Internationale Studien- und Ausbildungspartnerschaften (ISAP)“ International Partnerships in Higher Education

The partnerships are arranged for specific fields
Credits are accepted, tuition fees are (partly) waived
Applications are submitted by the German university

The DAAD provides financial support for the German students and the German partner institution.

Programs to intensify cooperation between German and North American university departments

Opportunities for Internationalizing Teaching

DAAD Visiting Professorship Program
3 months to 4 years, depending on model
Compensation according to the salary scales for German universities
Additional allowances for travel, luggage and health insurance
Co-financing by the German university
Application by the German university to DAAD Bonn



„Kurzzzeitdozentur“

1-6 months, co-financing by host university
DAAD covers travel costs and provides daily/monthly allowances
Applications have to be submitted to DAAD Bonn



Grads/Undergrads: Summer Courses

- **Summer courses (3 to 4 weeks) at German universities in hundreds of topics (but with a focus on aspects of contemporary Germany)**
- **Combine coursework with language learning**
- **Scholarships only for courses taught in German – 2 years minimum language requirement**

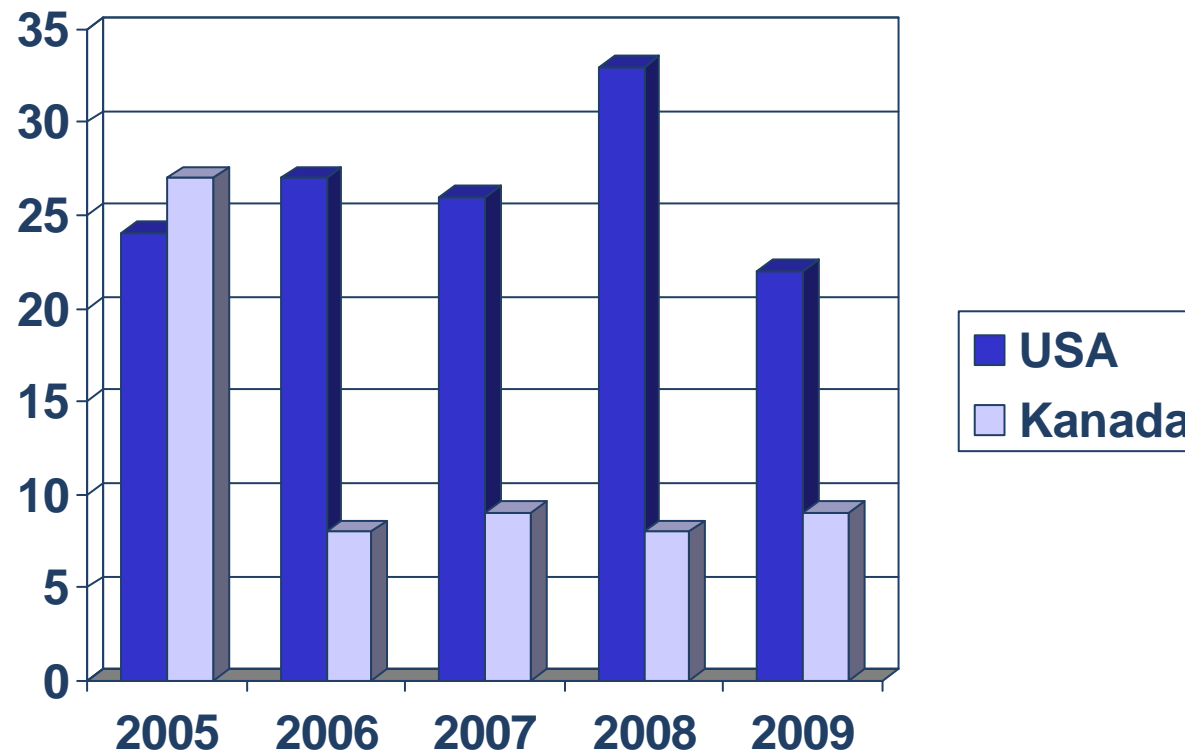

PPP USA/Kanada: Funding 2005 – 2009

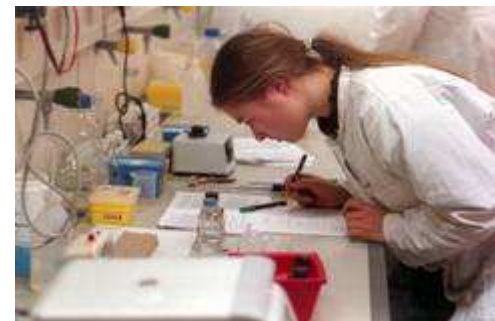

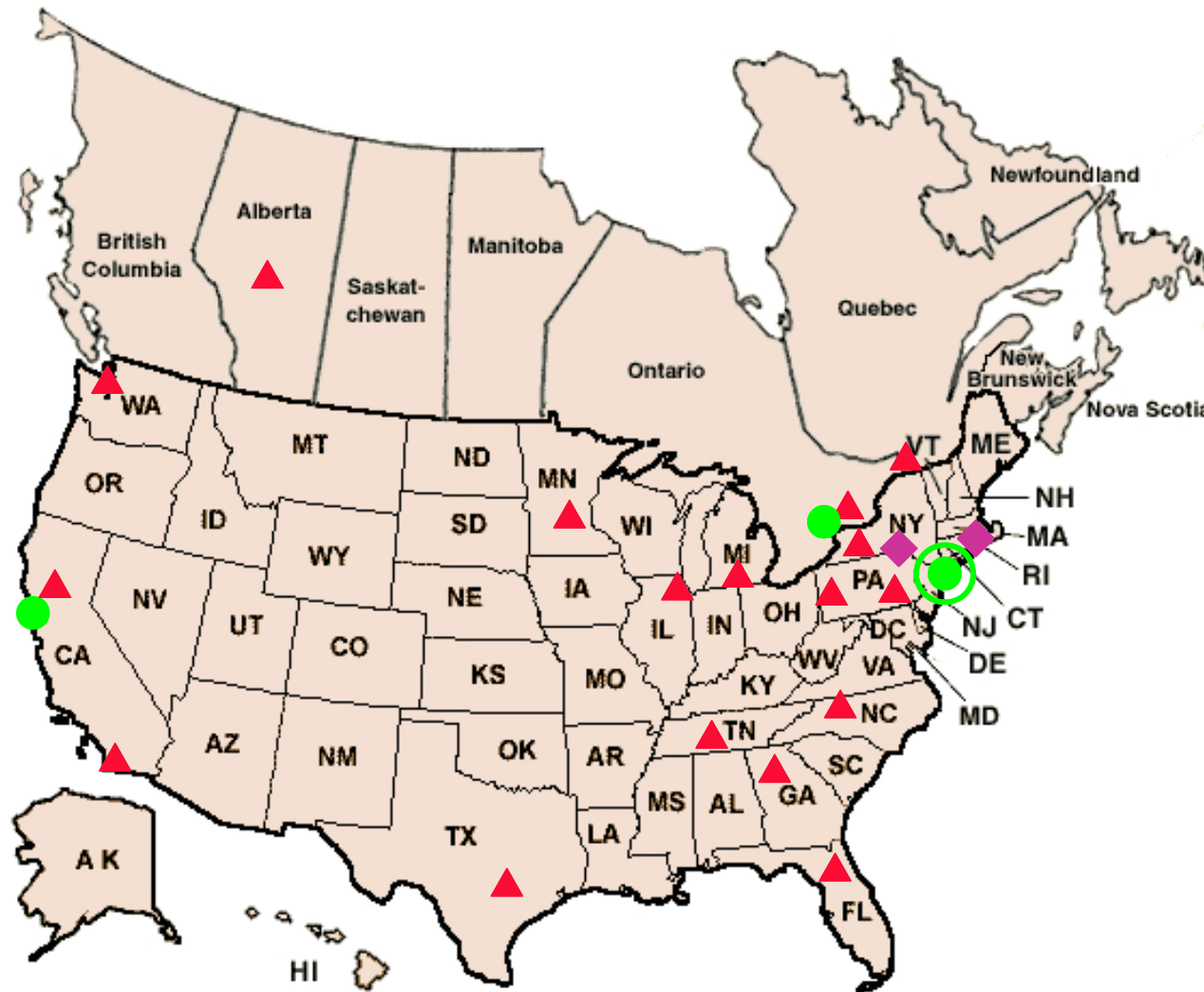
