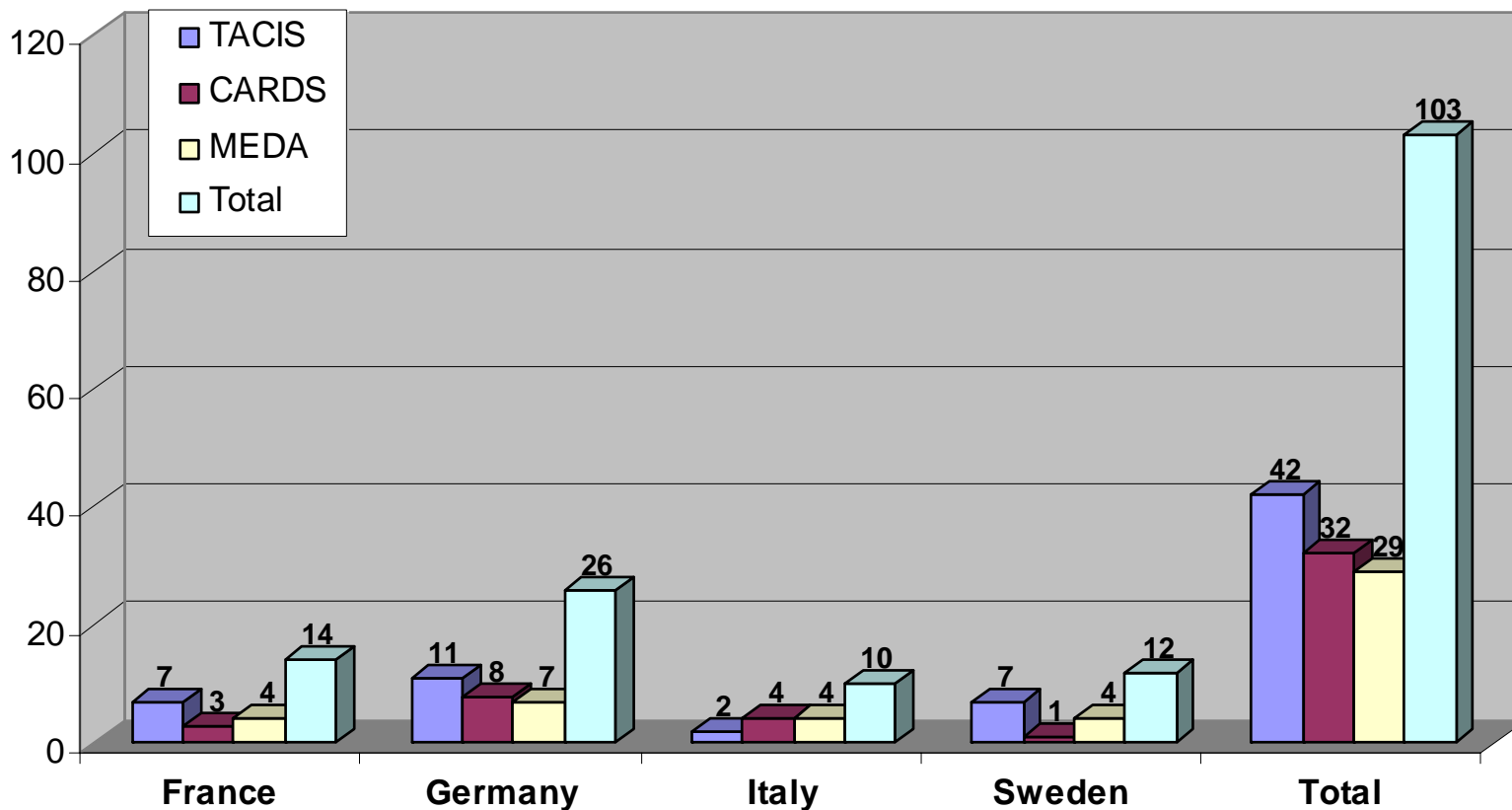

### Joint European Projects Selection Round 2006

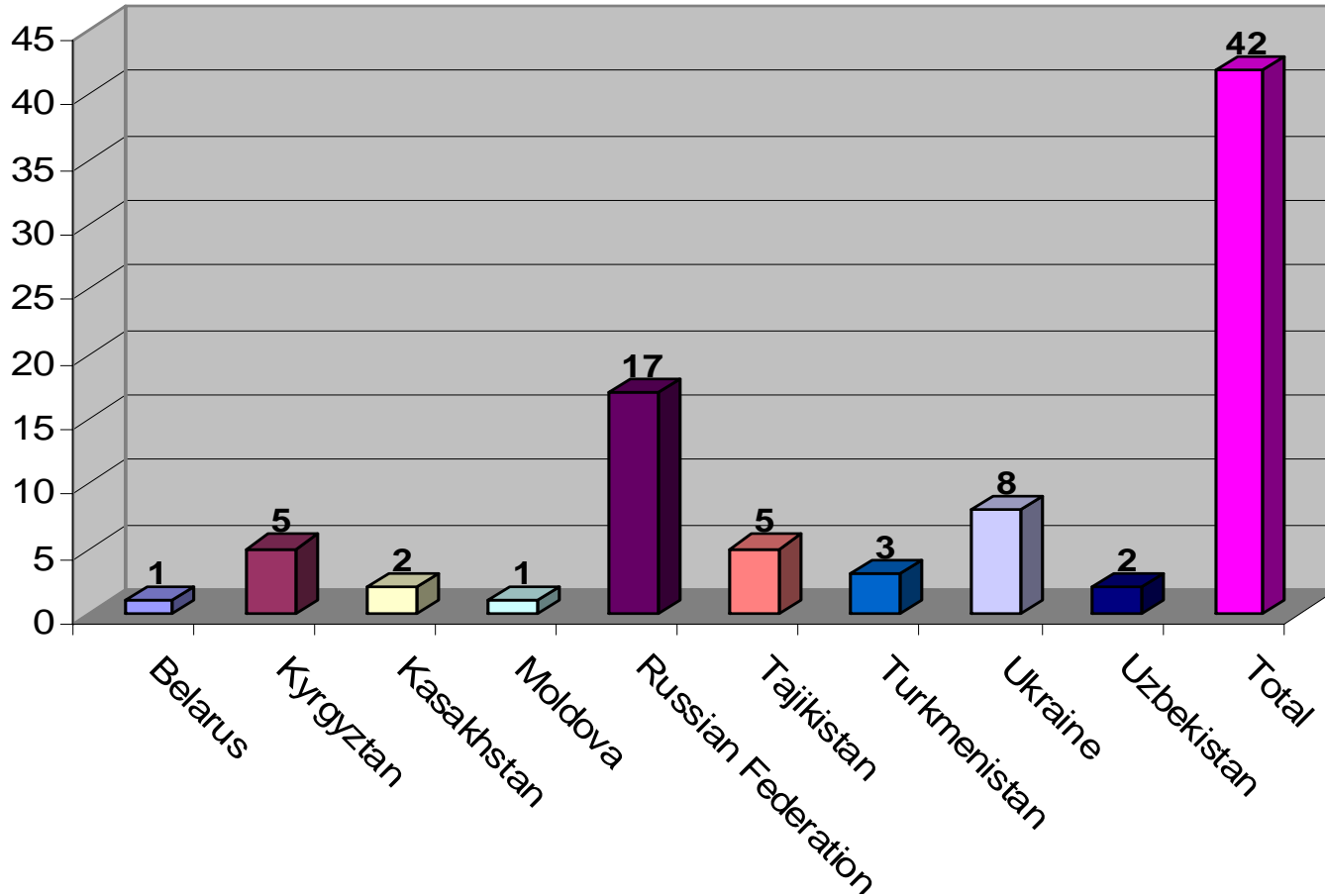

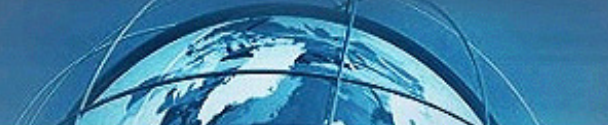

- ENPI – *European Neighbourhood and Partnership Instrument* covering **Eastern Europe and the Mediterranean**
- DCI – *Development Cooperation Instrument* covering **Central Asia**
- IPA – *European Instrument for Pre-Accession* covering the **Western Balkans**

### **New**

- **Individual Mobility Grants (IMGs) are closed down**
- **Just one deadline per year for all types of grants**
- **Higher education institutions in the partner countries can act as grant applicants and grantholders**



## Erasmus Mundus *External Cooperation Window* from 2006 on

### Mobility scheme addressing student and academic exchanges with Third Countries

➤ **Geographical coverage for first call for proposals (closed)**

TEMPUS Partner Countries plus Iraq, Iran, Israel and Yemen

➤ **Funded activities**

Student and staff mobility (grants from EUR 1000 up to 2500 per month)

Organisation of mobility

➤ **Size of grants**

Between EUR 1 million and 6 million for last call of proposals, new budget is not yet decided

**Important**

**Second call for proposals is expected for 2007 including Russia once again**

## International Cooperation in the 7th EU-Framework Programme for Research (FP 7: 2007-2013)



### Objectives

- **supporting European competitiveness**
- **strategic partnerships with third countries**
- **tackling specific problems that third countries face or that have a global character  
(basis: mutual interest and mutual benefit)**



## International Cooperation in the 7th EU-Framework Programme for Research (FP 7: 2007-2013)



### Budget for FP 7 (2007-2013)

1) Cooperation	€32,413 billion	} €50,521 billion
2) Ideas (European Research Council)	€ 7,51 billion	
3) People (Marie-Curie-Actions)	€ 4,75 billion	
4) Capacities (€180 Million for intern. coop. activities)	€ 4,097 billion	
5) JRC (Joint Research Center)	€ 1,751 billion	



## International Cooperation in the 7th EU-Framework Programme for Research (FP7: 2007-2013)



### COOPERATION

#### 10 Themes:

1. Health
  2. Food, agriculture and biotechnology
  3. Information and communication technologies
  4. Nanosciences, nanotechnologies, materials and new production technologies
  5. Energy
  6. Environment (including climate change)
  7. Transport (including aeronautics)
  8. Socio-economic sciences and the humanities
  9. Space
  10. Security
- all themes open to third countries
  - minimum: 3 different EU-States or Associated Countries + third countries



## International Cooperation in the 7th EU-Framework Programme for Research (FP7: 2007-2013)



### Specific International Cooperation Actions (SICA)

linked to the 10 themes

- minimum 4 participants from *different* countries:  
2 ICPC (International Cooperation Partner Countries) + 2 Member States or Associated Countries
- SICAs are the continuation of the INCO actions and follow largely the previous INCO rules

### Special SICAs for cooperation with RUSSIA in „Food, agriculture and biotechnology“ (Theme 2)

- Novel methods of treatment of animal by-products
- Plants as Edible Vaccines ■
- Industrial Enzymes: Rational design of biocatalysts and enzyme systems with requested properties

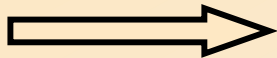

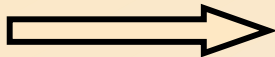

- €6 Million
