## Goals and Expenditures of the DAAD in 2007

### Scholarships for foreigners

Promoting young foreign elites at German universities and research institutes

**61 mio euros**

### Scholarships for Germans

Promoting young German leaders of the future in their studies and research abroad (including ERASMUS)

**77 mio euros**

### Internationalisation of German universities

Increasing the international appeal of German universities (including marketing) and promoting the international dimension in German higher education

**57 mio euros**

### Promoting German studies and the German language abroad

Promoting German studies, German language and area studies programmes (including Lektors) at foreign universities

**37 mio euros**

### Educational cooperation with developing countries

Promoting academic, economic, and democratic development in developing and reform countries

**45 mio euros**

## Partnerships with Universities in Developing Countries

- /// subject-related partnerships since 1997
- /// funds available for mobility and to a limited extent for equipment and staff
- /// programme encourages the establishment of multilateral networks and south-south co-operation
- /// **objectives:** development of joint curricula, training modules and degree programmes with applied research
- /// typical examples: labour law (South Africa), integrated watershed management (Tanzania, Kenya, Ethiopia, Uganda), agribusiness (Chile, Costa Rica)



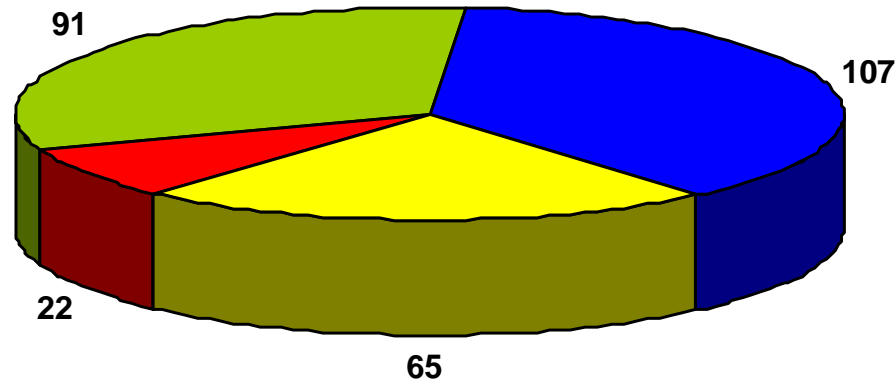
**2007 almost all 93 partnerships with higher education institutions covered the MDGs**

■ Africa Subsahara ■ Northern Africa / Near East ■ Latin America ■ Asia

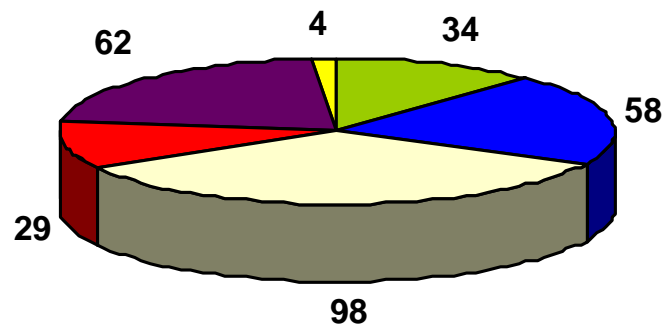

## Fact Finding Missions

### Objectives

- to prepare a “subject-related partnership”
- to support scientific delegations to visit different higher education institutions and relevant ministries to detect the partner institution’s demand on a departmental or institutional level

### Measures

- promotion of mobility of Germans
- funding per project



**38 Fact Finding Missions were accomplished in 2007**



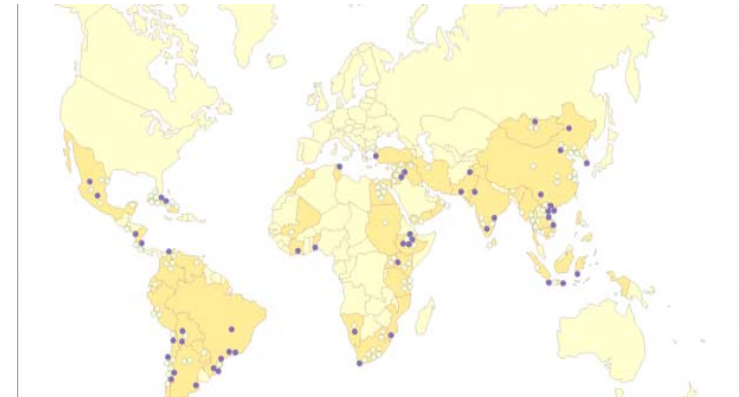
## Advisory & Consulting Projects

### Consultation by professors, emeriti, administrators

- to improve administrative orders in the partner institutions
- to initiate projects for economic co-operation and community based projects
- to network projects regarding the German development co-operation
- to build up academic and technological transfer centers at the partner institutions
- to organize research projects

### Target group

- local expert pool
- expertise from the higher education field



**33 advisory & consulting projects were supported in 2007**



## Medical Programme

Scientific preparation for medicine and dentistry students from developing countries studying in Germany for re-integration in their home countries

### Objectives:

- qualification of students, graduates and alumni
- integration of scientists, graduates, students
- creation of alumni networks



### Measures:

- partnerships with higher education institutions (curriculum development and exchange of professors and students)
- weekend workshops in Germany
- summer schools in Germany or abroad
- expert workshops abroad
- clinical electives on location

**9 medical projects were supported in 2007**



## Alumni Programme



### Module 1

Experts workshops  
week-long advanced training courses/ workshops on location  
max. € 25.000 per event

### Module 2

Summer schools  
two-week summer schools in Germany or abroad  
max. € 60.000 per event

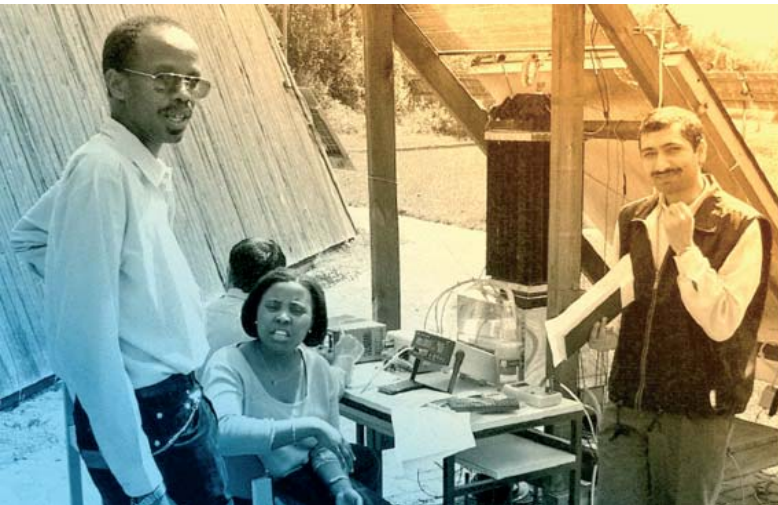
### Module 3

Networks  
activities to create and extend subject related networks  
max. € 7.000 per year



## Example - German Alumni Water Network (GAWN)

- **Start = Capacity Building**
  - 5 Postgraduate courses at German universities
- **2005 IFAT Munich, 3 Summerschools and 1 Forum with 75 Alumni**
- **2006 / 2007 – Regional activities in Tunisia, Jordan and Syria, Kenya and Tanzania, Philippines and Brazil**
- **Well Drilling – Fair Geofora 2007 in Hof**
- **IFAT 2008 in Munich !!!**
