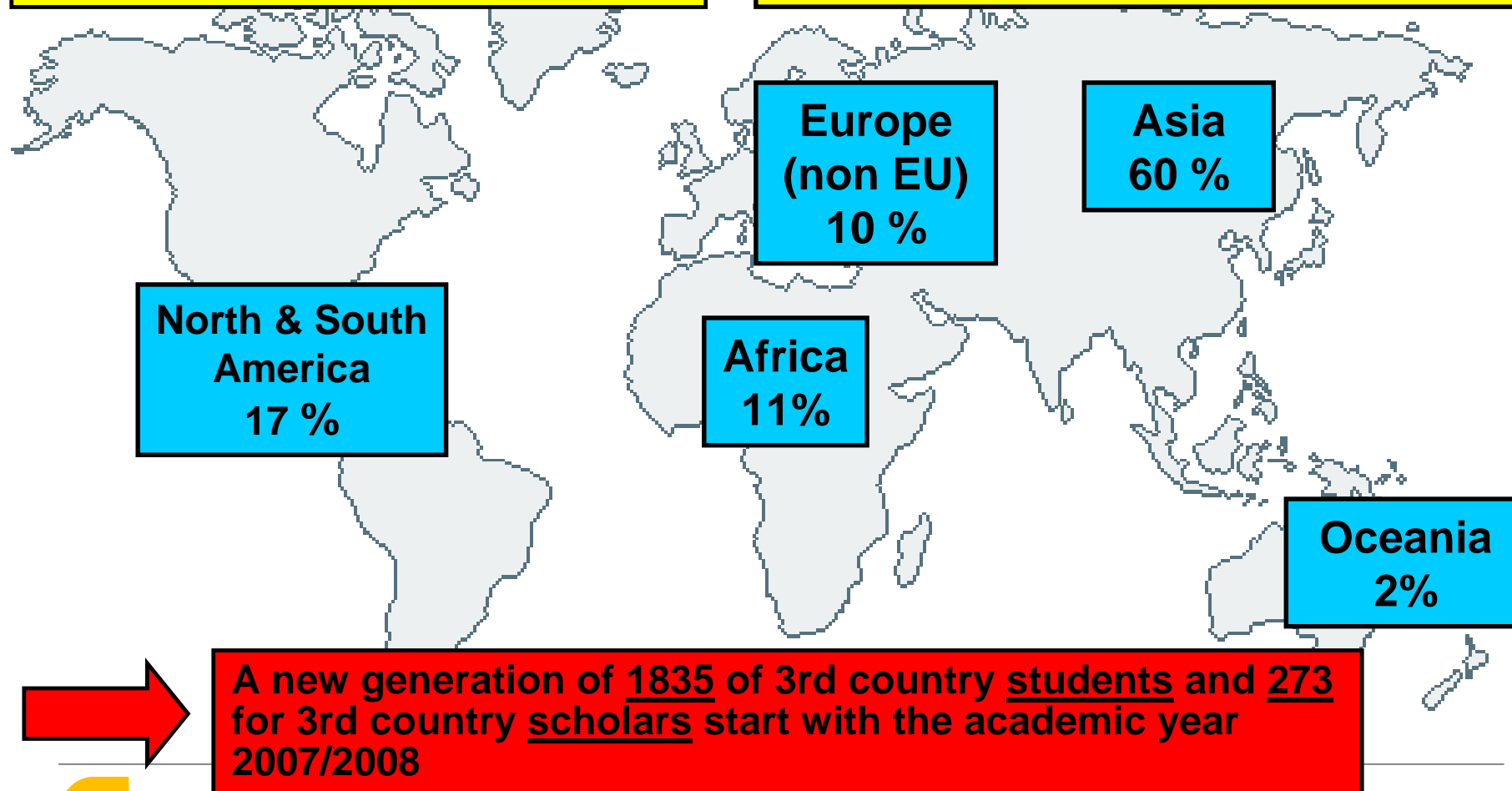
- **European Integration (Bologna Process)**

## Action 1

**369 European HEI involved in 80 EM courses**

**37 with German participation (9 co.+ 28 partners)**

2004: 13 German institutions / 19 EM courses

2005: 8 German institutions / 17 EM courses

2006: 5 German institutions / 21 EM courses

2007: 11 German institutions / 23 EM courses
